

What to Expect During Construction

CONSTRUCTION TIMING AND INFORMATION

- Early work activities within existing right of way will begin in late fall 2017
- Construction will ramp up in spring 2018
- Construction to take place throughout the 22.5 mile corridor for duration of project
- Construction and traffic impact Information communicated to public via Transform66.org, social media, TV, radio, print media, roadway signage
- Work with local communities to be good neighbors during construction
- Provide advance construction information to adjacent communities and address issues of concern

WHAT YOU WILL SEE DURING CONSTRUCTION

- Construction will be completed in phases to keep traffic moving:
 - In Phase 1, traffic will typically be shifted to the inside of the corridor and construction will occur on the outside
 - In Phase 2, traffic will typically be shifted to the outside of the corridor and construction will occur on the inside
- No lane closures will occur during peak periods
- Access to residential areas and businesses will be maintained in current configurations

TYPICAL PHASED CONSTRUCTION APPROACH



Phase 1: Traffic is shifted to the inside of the corridor



Phase 2: Traffic is shifted to the outside of the corridor
