

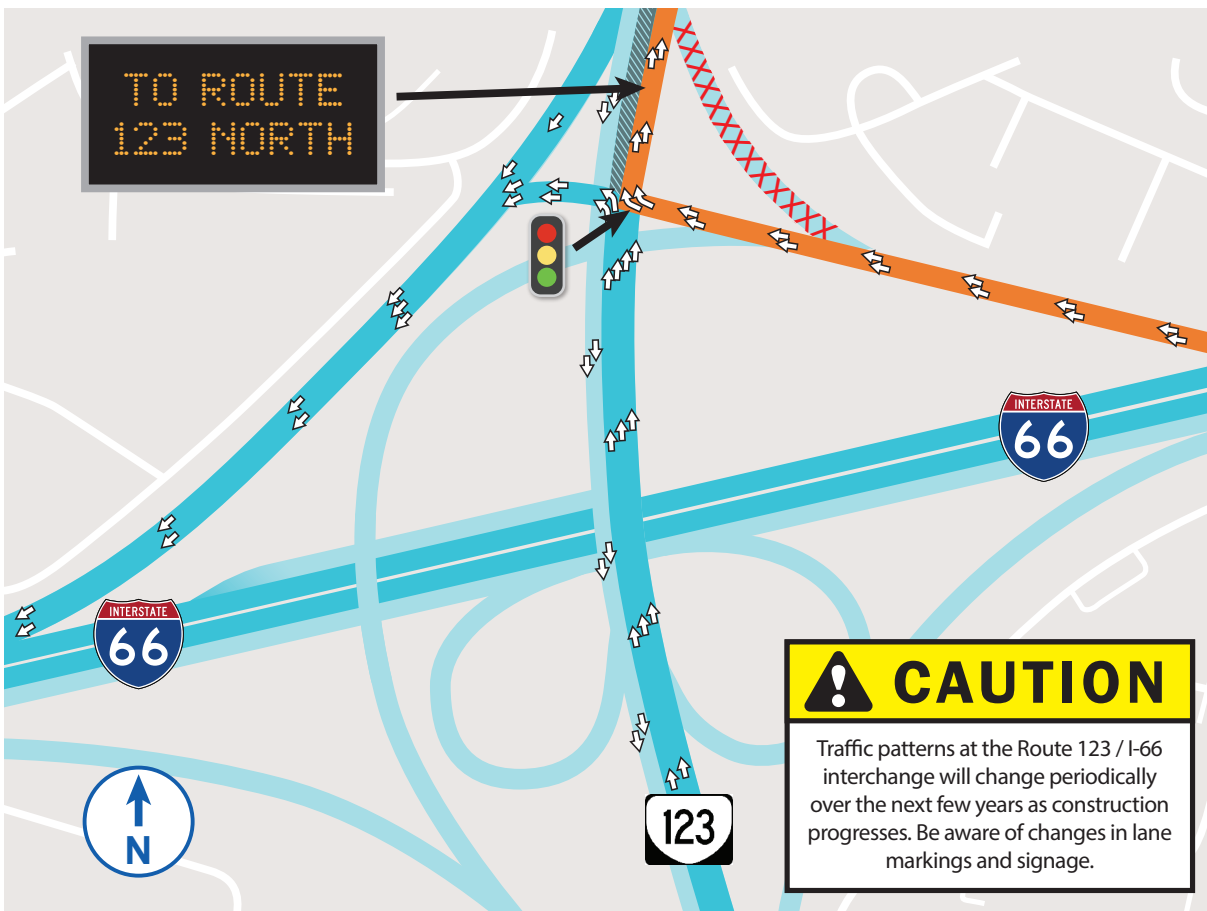
Traffic Pattern Changes at I-66 and Route 123 (Chain Bridge Road) Interchange Starting on or about August 14

The Route 123 interchange is being re-constructed to provide direct access to and from the future eastbound and westbound I-66 Express Lanes. These improvements require a series of traffic pattern changes during construction.

Starting on or about August 14, 2019, drivers traveling on I-66 West to Route 123 (Chain Bridge Road) North toward Oakton will use a new, temporary exit ramp for approximately three months. The temporary ramp will have two right-turn lanes and a traffic signal to allow drivers to access Route 123 North. The ramp from I-66 West to Route 123 South will continue to be in use during this time.

Drivers traveling north on Route 123 should remain aware of this temporary traffic change, and should use caution and be alert for vehicles entering the roadway.

During construction, drivers should expect additional traffic pattern changes at the interchange. Use caution and pay attention to lane markings and roadway signs.
