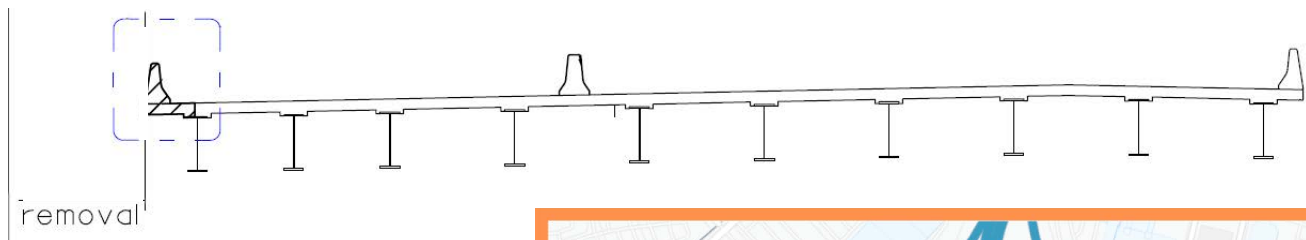


Partial Bridge Demolition of I-66 Bridges Over Route 286 (Fairfax County Parkway)

On or about Thursday, February 13, 2020, partial demolition will begin on three of the I-66 bridges over Route 286. The I-66 bridges are being widened to provide room for future Express Lanes and future mass transit as part of the Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Project.

- Partial demolition will occur on the outermost portion of the I-66 bridges over Route 286
- All demolition work will occur behind barrier with no travel impacts to I-66
- Demolition will begin on the northern most bridge span over Route 286 North and will progress south. Demolition will take about 6 weeks, weather dependent
 - Demolition activities will occur during overnight hours (10 p.m. - 5 a.m.) when travel lanes of Route 286 can be closed
- Demolition is anticipated to be complete by March 26, 2020
- Currently no demolition work is scheduled to occur over the weekend (schedule is subject to change dependent on weather)

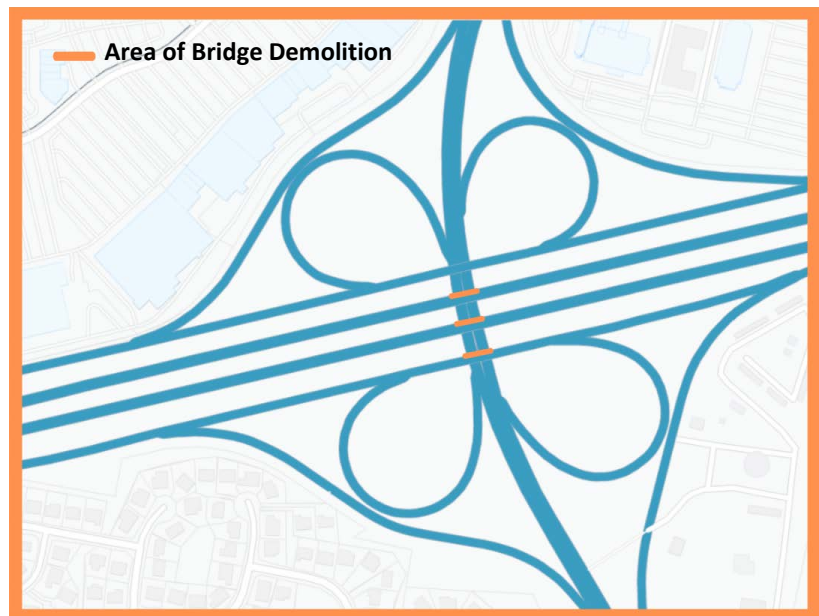


Minimizing Impacts to Neighbors

Some construction and demolition activities will generate noise or other impacts. When those activities occur, measures will be taken to minimize impacts.

During Demolition:

- Sand will be used to dampen drop noise in closed travel lanes when possible
- Concrete will be processed off site
- Noise will be monitored during overnight demolition operations
- Lighting will be directed towards roadway
- Dust control measures will be in place
