I-66 Outside the Beltway Project Lane Closures and Traffic Changes Weekend Reminders for May 7-8, 2021, and Planned Closures for the Week of May 9, 2021

[Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Project](#) construction continues throughout the corridor during [daytime and overnight hours](#) as weather conditions allow.

I-66 East and West will be closed at Route 123 (Chain Bridge Road) during the overnight hours Friday, May 7, and Saturday, May 8, for overhead bridge beam installation. [Details](#)

During the overnight hours of May 10-11 and May 14-15, I-66 West approaching I-495 will be closed for overhead bridge beam installation. The ramps from I-495 North to I-66 West and the 495 Express Lanes South to I-66 West will also be closed. Additional overnight lane closures and stoppages will occur on I-66 West May 12-13. Upcoming openings:

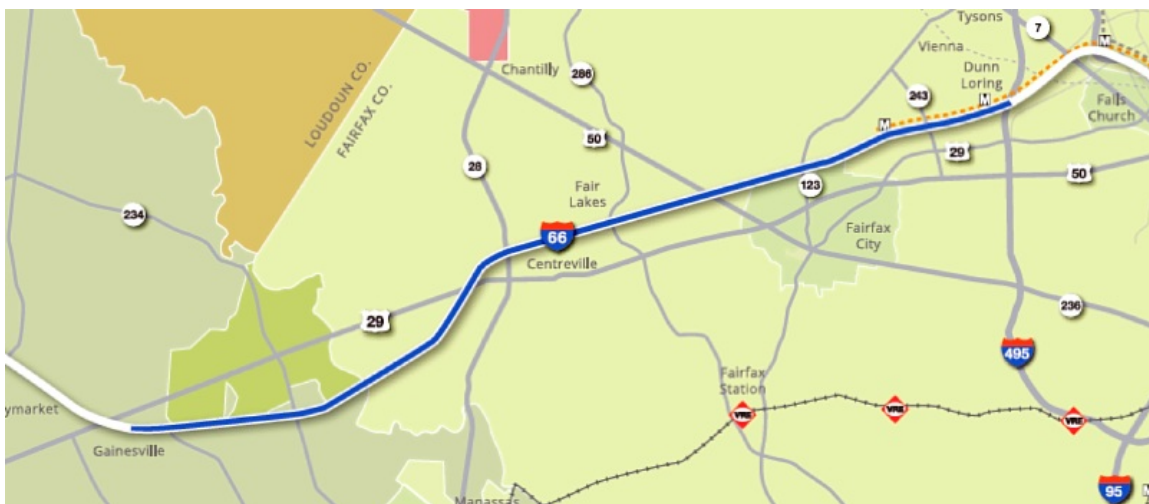
- Traffic on Jermantown Road is planned to shift to the new bridge over I-66 during the daytime hours Friday, May 14. [Details](#)

Significant upcoming traffic impacts include:

- During the overnight hours of May 7-8, I-66 West approaching I-495 will be reduced to one travel lane for overhead bridge beam installation. The 495 Express Lanes South approaching I-66, and the ramps from I-66 East and West to the 495 Express Lanes South will also be closed.
- During the overnight hours of May 7-8 and May 10-15, Gallows Road over I-66 will be reduced to a single lane in each direction for bridge work. Southbound Gallows Road will be closed with two-way traffic running in the northbound lanes. [Details](#)
- Overnight ramp closures are planned at the following I-66 interchanges: I-495, Nutley Street, Route 50, and Route 28.

Current activities include:

- **Bridge beam installation on I-66 at I-495 and Route 123**
- **Bridge demolition at Jermantown Road**
- Small charge blasting along I-66 West at Route 234 Business (Sudley Road)
- Paving on I-66 East and West in Prince William County, Centreville, Oakton, and Vienna
- Constructing bridge foundations at Route 28, Route 286 (Fairfax County Parkway), Route 50, Waples Mill Road, Route 123, and I-495
- Bridge deck work for expanded bridges over University Boulevard, Compton Road, Cub Run, and Bull Run
- Bridge deck work for new bridges at Route 50, Jermantown Road, Gallows Road, and I-66 bridges over I-495
- Relocating underground utilities along I-66 East and West
- Earthwork and drainage along I-66 East and West
- Constructing retaining walls and noise walls along I-66 and Route 28
- Corridor-wide roadway maintenance as needed



The Transform 66 Outside the Beltway Project will add express lanes stretching 22.5 miles from the Capital Beltway to Route 29 in Gainesville, rebuild major interchanges along the I-66 corridor, create thousands of new park and ride spaces, and expand trail options for cyclists and pedestrians. The right lane of Route 28 North at I-66 will remain closed to provide an

extended merge lane for the ramp from I-66 East to Route 28 North.

Eastbound and Westbound I-66 will be closed approaching Route 123 (Chain Bridge Road). All traffic will be directed to exit the interstate at Route 123, stay to the left on the ramps, and then continue across Route 123 to the ramps to return to I-66.
