

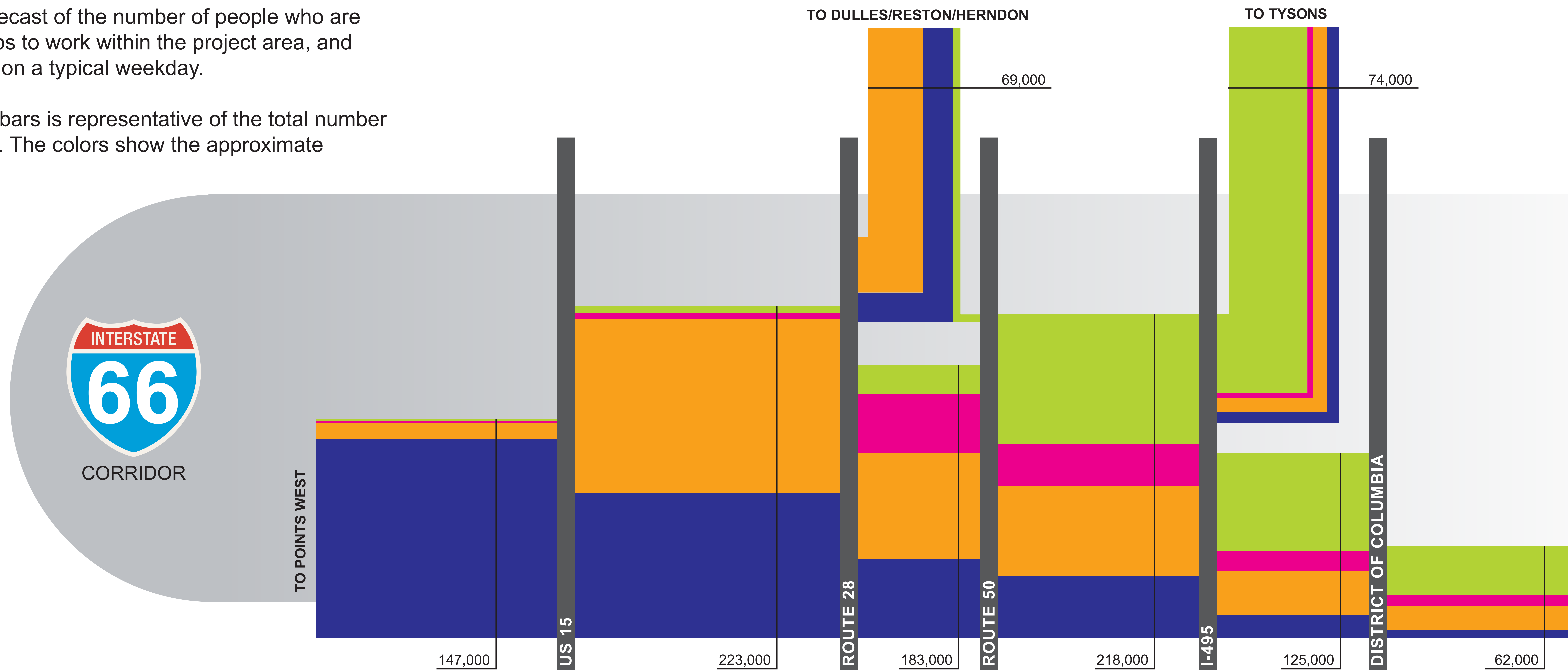
WHERE PEOPLE TRAVEL

PROJECTED FUTURE (2040) HOME TO WORK TRIPS

This figure shows the forecast of the number of people who are expected to start their trips to work within the project area, and travel in the I-66 corridor on a typical weekday.

The overall height of the bars is representative of the total number of people in the segment. The colors show the approximate breakdown by trip origin.

For example:
 In the segment between US 15 and Route 28, approximately 223,000 people will start trips from within the study area and travel on I-66 to work. Approximately one-third of those trips originate west of US 15 (blue portion).



Home to work trips originating from...

- West of US 15 (Blue)
- Between US 15 and Route 28 (Orange)
- Between Route 28 and Route 50 (Pink)
- Between Route 50 and I-495 (Green)
